New Central Park Proposed for Dingley Village

Redevelopment plans for the former golf course site in Dingley Village include a large multi-purpose public park at the geographic centre of Dingley Village on Centre Dandenong Road — the “Entry Reserve”.

The Entry Reserve will contain many of the existing mature trees and include an expansive wetland that will support flora and fauna local to the area.

It will become the central park for Dingley Village, convenient to residents across the suburb.

This new centrally located park will provide a range of facilities supporting recreational and leisure activities focused on bringing the community together including:

- basketball and netball rings
- an all abilities themed children’s playground
- picnic tables and shelters
- barbecue facilities
- contoured landscaping creating an amphitheatre where community concerts and other events can be held

A new public car park will be built to support visitors who drive to the new park, while pedestrian and bike access will be made easy through a network of newly created walking and cycling trails connecting the new neighborhood into the surrounding community.
